

Highly Valuable NFTs for FREE



Although you can secure highly valuable NFTs at a discounted price when you are whitelisted, you can also secure highly valuable NFTs for FREE.

**NOTE:** Being whitelisted for an NFT project means that you have followed a certain number of requirements (such as following the NFT project's Twitter account, joining their Discord server and sharing their Discord server with friends) in order to be able to purchase their NFTs at a discount and benefit from other perks prior to the NFTs going on sale to the general public.

By securing NFTs for free, means that your NFT investment is completely risk free. You benefit from the same perks NFT holders enjoy, WITHOUT having to spend money.

For example, the NFT CryptoPunks collection that was launched in 2017 gave away 10,000 NFTs from their collection to anyone with an ETH wallet. A few years later, these NFTs were worth millions of dollars.

So why do some NFT projects give their NFTs for free at first? The success of NFT projects heavily relies on how large and engaged their community is, and how much their community helps spread the word about them. Therefore giving away free NFTs at the beginning of their launch helps them spread the word.

For example, another highly successful NFT project called NFT Worlds, also gave away some NFTs for free. These NFTs within weeks of their launch were worth thousands of dollars (their price went up to 15 ETH at some stage).

So how do you find promising NFT projects that give NFTs for free?


Well, all you need is a Twitter account.

Then, type in the search box "NFT giveaway" or "Free NFT" and then press "enter" on your keyboard.





When you do, you'll be able to scroll through all the tweets that include these keywords:






You'll notice that several accounts are giving away NFTs for free. To qualify for a free NFT, you simply need to follow the requirements they've outlined in their tweet.

In the example above, the requirements are:


- Follow @justape\_
- 2. Like and retweet their tweet
- 3. Tag 3 friends

To follow them, simply click on their username @justape\_ in the tweet and click on "follow".






Then go back to their tweet, and like and retweet the tweet.



The third step is to tag 3 friends. In order to do so, you will need to click on retweet and then select "quote Tweet":





Then, you can add any comment and add the username of 3 of your friends:




Add a comment and add the username of 3 friends


Usually, they announce the winners on Twitter a few days later:

If your Twitter username is listed in their tweet, they will ask you to send them a direct message to share your wallet address.

To send a direct message on Twitter, simply click on the envelope:



<u>IMPORTANT:</u> NFT giveaways can have different requirements. Some might ask you to engage on their Discord server for example. The selection criteria varies greatly from one NFT project to another. Don't expect to get a free NFT each time you apply. To increase your chances of winning a free NFT, keep on applying for different ones.

Also, not all NFTs you receive for free will end up being worth much.

To make sure the NFTs you secure have the potential to really increase in value over time, make sure that:

- 1. The NFT project has a larged and engaged community of followers on Discord and Twitter (over 10,000 followers at least on each social network)
- 2. There are many people engaging on their Discord and on their tweets (hundreds of retweets and comments per tweet they publish is a very good sign)
- 3. Articles in the media have been published about the NFT project and that they are neutral or positive
- The majority of social media comments published about the NFT project are positive (their community is not overly critical about the project and there aren't many disgruntled followers)

So there you have it! The proven method for identifying NFT giveaways and potentially winning one.

<u>CAUTION:</u> There are many scams out there. To receive a free NFT you will NOT need to provide your login details, recovery phrase or seed phrase of your wallet. You won't need to send cryptocurrency to another wallet. If anyone messages you privately to tell you they want to give you a free NFT and then asks for money to be sent to their wallet, or if they ask for your wallet login details, recovery phrase or seed phrase, or any other personal information, DO NOT GIVE IT.
